Background


- Facility Advisory Committee <u>Recommendation</u>:
 - Met July 7, 2016 April 13, 2017
 - "... the committee has determined they are not equipped to assess the development potential for properties that might be considered for repurposing."
- District <u>Budget</u> Situation:
 - Evergreen's 2018-2019 budget development reflects an \$18 million deficit and a \$20.6 million shortfall in meeting our 3% required reserve in 2020-2021.
- Current Facility Usage:
 - Primarily after-school enrichment programs
 - 2016-17 Revenue Generated: \$642,407.83
 - Goal is to realize \$400-800K additional revenue
