
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
#### Boundaries – CURRENT BOUNDARIES



Current Elementary Attendance Areas plus Meadowfair with Attendance Area between Tully, King and Capitol




#### **Boundaries – NORTH WEST REGION**

### FACILITIES CONDITIONS

Part of the charter for the Facilities Advisory Committee (FAC) was to assess the conditions of all EESD facilities. To accomplish this, the committee organized two field trips to visit the school sites and district offices. Summaries of each site assessment are noted in the meeting minutes of the FAC.

The overall conditions of the properties vary based on age, updates and repairs that need to be done. This is to be expected with any type of facility (i.e. commercial, business, residential, etc.). At the time of the assessments, all properties were being used as intended by design.

The FAC does not think that the conditions of any of the facilities should be a consideration in potential recommendations for repurposing of any of the schools/other properties.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Martin Property (on San Felipe Road)
  - Develop property to generate revenue.
- Meadowfair School
  - Not economically viable at this point of enrollment decline AND if you did, you would need to repurpose a 3<sup>rd</sup> school.



## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Laurelwood
  - Repurpose and consolidate with Cadwallader and other neighboring schools.
- Dove Hill
  - Repurpose and change boundaries to accommodate students at neighboring schools.



## RECOMMENDATIONS

- OB Whaley/Katherine Smith
  - Change boundaries to absorb Meadowfair students.
- District Office
  - Relocate District Office to a repurposed site and develop existing DO site for revenue generation. OR put a two story on existing site and redevelop remaining portion of site for revenue generation.
