Eligibility to Participate in Sports

Eligibility to participate in sports at Chaboya Middle School is determined at the regular reporting periods: either quarterly report cards or progress reports. A GPA of 2.0 and no “F” grade is the minimum requirement. At the beginning of each sport, all student athletes are considered on “probation” until the regular quarterly report card or progress report, which comes out during their respective season, is issued. The date this official report is distributed at school is the “cut date”. Students who do not meet the minimum requirement are not eligible to participate in practices or events. They are dropped from the team roster. A student who becomes ineligible for one sport may try out for a future sport. The same eligibility requirements will apply.

Prior to the regular reporting period, students will be asked to print the following form and have it completed and signed by all the student’s teachers. Failure to submit the completed form in the timeframe requested by your coach will impact your eligibility.
