Every Wednesday is Walk n' Roll to School Day for students. Laurelwood families are encouraged to walk, bike and/or roll to school each Wednesday to promote daily physical activity, reduce traffic congestion and learn critical skills that enhance biking and pedestrian safety. A "Lion Pass" will be given to each student so they can receive a special hole punch from a parent volunteer, or staff member wearing a bright yellow vest **beginning at 7:55 am** at the following two points:

1. Evergreen Way and Partridge Drive
2. Buena Park Court and Buena View Court.

Our drop-off loop will be **CLOSED** each Wednesday morning until 8:15am to ensure safe passage for students on to campus. The loop will be open in the afternoon for dismissal. Students can earn special prizes in the office during first recess **for every 5 hole punches** they receive.

Students must get their "Lion Pass" punched at these drop-off/walking points to earn the prizes.
